By using the platform, you agree to these terms and conditions and our privacy policy. In these terms and conditions, the words "platform" refers to the ARES mobile application, the ARES web application, the ARES desktop application and the ARES website together, "we", "us", "our" and "ARES" refers to ARES and "you" and "user" refers to you, the ARES user.

The following terms and conditions apply to your use of the platform. This includes mobile and tablet versions, as well as any other version of ARES accessible via desktop, mobile, tablet, social media or other devices.

PLEASE READ THESE CONDITIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE DOWNLOADING AND USING THE FUNCTIONALITIES AVAILABLE ON THE PLATFORM.

1. ACCEPTANCE OF TERMS

By using the platform, you agree to be bound by this agreement. If you do not agree to the terms of this agreement, you must not use our platform. We may modify this agreement from time to time, and such modification will be effective upon posting on the platform.
